- Duct leakage report for new ducts in unconditioned spaces

Engineering inspections

- Utility disconnect; water, sanitary

Do not connect water service to building or fire systems until water main flush inspection approval

- Grease duct welds (on the ground light test prior to hanging or installing)
- Mechanical hood and duct (over cooking equipment)
- Grease duct wrap (all layers to be inspected separately)
- Hood and duct suppression

- Fire pump acceptance test and inspections
- Final fire sprinkler, and/or standpipe, and/or hose valves
- Fire alarm (rough wiring, open ceiling, and final)
- Open ceiling alarm wiring

- Knox Box and all required copies of keys.

No occupancies will be approved without all required above fire inspection approvals.
