PROJECT SCOPE: Construction of a concrete bike/pedestrian path, storm sewer installation, landscaping and minor lighting improvements.

IMPROVEMENTS: The proposed project is located along the west side of Lehigh/Harlem Avenue between Glenview Road and Chestnut Avenue. This project was funded through a federal CMAQ grant. The portion of the trail between Lake Avenue and Chestnut Avenue is construction but not yet striped and signed. The remaining portion south of Lake Avenue will complete the trail between The Glen Metra train station and the downtown Metra train station and Glenview Library and will provide opportunities for future bike lanes and/or paths extending south, east, and west of Glenview Road and Harlem Avenue as outlined in the Village's Bicycle and Sidewalk Master Plan. New bike racks will be installed near the Glenview Park District offices. Additional detention storm sewer will be constructed to offset the runoff from the proposed improvements.
