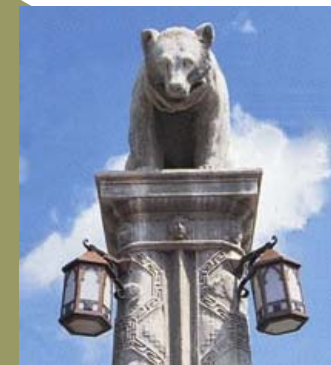

Plan Commission

The Plan Commission is charged **with managing development in the Village** in order to ensure that Glenview maintains its balance of high residential standards and thriving businesses, its open spaces and public places.

Made up of seven Glenview residents appointed by the Board of Trustees, it is a recommending body: all decisions must be approved by the Board.

The Commission:

- Reviews **proposals regarding property development**, from businesses planning to put up a new building and property owners wishing to subdivide their land to stores reconfiguring their parking lots.
- Makes **recommendations regarding approval** of such development to the Board.
- Makes recommendations regarding the **annexation of land into incorporated Glenview**.
- Recommends **changes to the Village Zoning Code** and approves **conditional use permits**.
- Ensures that development **fits into the Village's Comprehensive Plan** and complies with existing Zoning Code, Site Plan Review and Subdivision Code ordinances.

Meetings

Commission meetings are generally held on the **second and fourth Tuesdays of each month at 7 p.m.** in the Village Hall Board Room, 1225 Waukegan Road. They are also broadcast live on GVTV.

Agendas are usually posted at the Village Hall on the Monday before each meeting; you can also visit www.glenview.il.us.

Meetings are sometimes canceled or re-scheduled. In addition, special meetings are sometimes scheduled to address key issues. To be sure, call the Village Development Department at 847.904.4340, visit www.glenview.il.us or watch GVTV.

Public Comment at Meetings

Comment is welcome **during public hearings on specific cases** coming before the Commission. Not every meeting includes a public hearing; check the agenda to find out which public hearings will be held at any given meeting. During a public hearing, **simply fill out a speaker card when you enter the room and give it to the Commission secretary.** The Chairman will call on you when appropriate.
