The Village's Citation Pre-Pay Program Might Be Right for You.

When the Village of Glenview issues a citation for a municipal code violation — whether it be for construction work without a permit, or stagnant water on the property — it automatically comes with a court date — which could cost up to \$750 in court fees (in addition to any fines).

Now, if your property has been cited for a *minor* violation, you can avoid a trip to court — and the court fees — by pre-paying your citation at Village Hall.

How Does the Citation Pre-Pay Program Work?

- At least a week before your scheduled court date, come into Village Hall and pay your fine. Fines range between \$50 and \$100.
- Bring your property into code compliance.
- Undergo a verification inspection by the Village.
- That's all there is to it!

Many minor violations can be handled "over the counter" at Village Hall and through a verification inspection — saving time and money.

Which Violations are Eligible for the Program?

- Work done without a permit.
- Garbage, waste, refuse violation
- Garbage put out too early
- Tree removal without a permit.
- Tall grass/weeds
- Vacant structure hazard
- Grade/drainage causing flooding problems on adjacent property
- Blocked sanitary or storm sewer
- Stagnant water
- Potable water violation
- Sump/gutter discharge
- Construction work before or after permitted hours
- Construction obstructing traffic
- Construction debris
- Dirt on roadway
- Dust from construction
- No certificate of occupancy
- No business license
- Failure to stop work after receiving a Stop Work Order.
- Landscape waste
- RV/boat parked on property
- Inoperable vehicle parked on street
- Sight obstruction
- Non-compliance with Appearance Commission regulations
- Landscaping violations
- Lack of appropriate screening
- Placing a banner without a permit
- Putting up an awning without a permit
- Putting up a sign without a permit
- More pets than permitted by code/noisy pets

- Too many occupants in a structure
- Obstruction in the right-of-way
- Danger to public safety
- Rodent/vermin on property
- Damage to Village property
- Lighting code violations
- Elevator code violations
- Swimming pool code violations
- Food service violations
- Daycare violations
- Nursing home violation
- Handicap accessibility
