



PEDDLER REGULATIONS

1. Peddler is defined in Article 9 of Chapter 6 of the Glenview Village Code. A Peddler is generally one who takes orders for or offers to sell or sells or seeks to obtain orders or sales from persons within the Village of Glenview. V.O. 6.43
2. Must make written application to the Village of Glenview. Must complete background check at Glenview Police Department. Two photos of application taken within 30 days are required. V.O. 6.45
3. Each peddler shall carry the license issued and shall exhibit same upon demand. V.O. 6.46(d)
4. No one having a Peddler's License shall offer for sale in the Village any kind of foods, goods, wares, merchandise or any article or any kind whatsoever on Sundays. V.O. 6.48
5. Selling from any vehicle is prohibited. V.O. 6.48.1
6. Hours of peddling are limited to 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. V.O. 6.50.1
7. No peddler may peddle at any premises if "**NO SOLICITORS OR PEDDLERS INVITED**" is posted. V.O. 6.50.3
8. Violation of any of the above regulations or otherwise conducting business in such a manner as to create a public nuisance or creates a danger to the public health, safety, or welfare, may result in revocation of the Peddler License and the right to solicit in Glenview. V.O. 6.50.5
