RESIDENTIAL DRIVEWAYS

Submittal Requirements:

- a. A permit application
- b. Two (2) copies of a current plat of survey showing existing and proposed driveway.

General Requirements:

- a. Concrete Driveways:
 - Approach 6 inch Portland Cement Concrete
 - 4 inch (min) IDOT CA-6 Crushed Stone
 - Driveway 4 inch Portland Cement Concrete
 - 4 inch (min) IDOT CA-6 Crushed Stone
- b. Asphalt Driveways:
 - Approach 3 inch Bituminous Asphalt 6 inch IDOT CA-6 Crushed Stone
 - Driveway 3 inch Bituminous Asphalt

4 inch IDOT CA-6 Crushed Stone

- c. Aggregate Driveways:
 - Approach 3 inch Bituminous Asphalt or 4 inch Portland Cement Concrete
 - 6 inch IDOT CA-6 Crushed Stone for Asphalt (or 4 inch for concrete)
 - Driveway Crushed Stone or Crushed Gravel
- d. Brick Pavers or other architectural paving materials will not be allowed in a driveway approach area without a building permit and <u>written permission</u> including a Hold Harmless Agreement from the Community Development Department.
- e. No fiber mesh shall be installed within the apron or the Village right-of-way.
- f. In a single-family residential zoning district, only one driveway curb cut per lot shall be permitted. A second curb cut may be allowed only if both of the following conditions are met:
 - a) A minimum 75 foot frontage (street lot line).
 - b) A minimum front setback of 45 feet for the principal structure on the lot.
- g. Driveway curb cuts must be located at least 20 feet from the edge of curb or pavement of adjacent public roadways, streets or intersections.
- h. Refer to Grading Plan Requirements.
- i. Show dimensions (A) through (D) per sketch below. No driveway shall be constructed so as to go through or intercede with an existing concrete public sidewalk. Indicate on the plan from the above recommendations the type and depth of materials to be used for driveway.
