## RESIDENTIAL FENCE REQUIREMENTS

## Permit required for:

- New fences
- Replacement of $50 \%$ or more of the total lineal footage of an existing fence within a 24 month period.


## Submittal Requirements:

- A permit application
- Two (2) copies of a current plat of survey showing the location, height and openness of fence


## General Requirements:

- One perimeter fence per lot
- Finished side of fence must face adjacent properties. Board on board is considered finished on both sides
- Plywood and 2 inch by 4 inch construction is prohibited
- Homeowner's association requirements may be stricter and are the responsibility of the homeowner.


## Yard Requirements:

- Fences in front or side yard adjacent to streets
o Maximum height is 4 feet
o Openings of at least $50 \%$ (see sketch below)
o Acceptable materials include: wood, wrought iron, aluminum faux wrought iron or faux wood
- Fences in rear yards or side yards (not adjacent to streets):
o Maximum height 7 feet
o May be solid
o Acceptable materials include: wood, wrought iron, aluminum faux wrought iron, faux wood, masonry, stone
- Fences in rear yards adjacent to streets or other public rights of way
o Minimum setback is 2 feet from lot line and 3 feet high year round landscaping. Required spacing of plantings is10 feet on center. An escrow is needed for planting equal to $110 \%$ of cost of plants.
0 If the rear yard is on a through lot and is across the street from a front yard on the street, the fence must be constructed to comply with Yard Requirement a. above Fences in front or side yards adjacent to streets.
