Update from NorthShore University HealthSystem

NorthShore University HealthSystem reports that e-visits, health hotline calls, and percentage of positive COVID-19 test results continues to grow. The hospitals continue to reach out to schools, civic groups, faith organizations and other groups to ensure that citizens know what the symptoms of COVID-19 are, and what to do if people experience any of the symptoms. 


