### **Reminders: Distancing, Masks & Group Limits**

In various parts of our community, we have seen many instances of people not distancing, not wearing masks, and gathering in groups larger than 10 people. We are in [Phase 3 of Restore Illinois](#), which requires people to keep 6 feet apart and wear masks at work, when shopping and in other public areas. Phase 3 also limits gatherings to no more than 10 people.

Please observe and comply with signage at places of business so that you can support their efforts to meet community needs while staying within the guidelines.
