- Cleanup
- Restoration: Benesch; Modjeski & Masters – discussion of findings
- Construction - Engineered fill/embankment
- Safety measures
 - ✓ FRA inspections
 - ✓ Train speed limitations
 - ✓ Train whistle protocol for construction workers; schedule
