Chuck Gitles was elected to the Village Board of Trustees in 2019.

He previously served on the Northbrook-Glenview District 30 School Board beginning in 2005, was elected to a second term in 2011, and a third term in 2015. He served as President from 2015 to 2019; served as the district representative to the North Shore Special Education District; led a successful referendum for the construction of a new Maple School; and completed three successful teacher contract negotiations.

Mr. Gitles is a Vice President at American Community Bank, where he is responsible for the banking needs of privately-held businesses in the Chicago area. Prior to that, he spent 25 years as a commercial banking relationship manager, serving both middle market and Fortune 500 clients. He also spent time as a management consultant working on operations and policy projects for banks nationwide.
