

**RESOLUTION NO. 16-80**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Glenview ("Village"), is a home rule municipality located in Cook County, Illinois;

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities have discussed the relocation of the Amtrak stop to the North Glen Metra Station, a two-level parking deck in the Downtown area, and multi-modal connections ("Project");

**WHEREAS**, the Village plans to submit a TIGER Grant application to secure federal funds to support up to 80% of the Project costs;

**WHEREAS**, the Village strongly supports the Project to improve the vitality of the Downtown Glenview area; and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities have determined that it is in the public interest to apply for a TIGER grant with the U.S. Department of Transportation to facilitate the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glenview, as follows:


