Appearance Commission

The Appearance Commission works to protect Glenview’s distinctive character by regulating the general appearance of many of its developments. The goal is to ensure that they are harmonious with their surroundings, contributing to a less cluttered, more attractive community.

The seven-member Commission, appointed by the Board of Trustees, includes architects, landscape architects, and at least one “owner, or an officer of a corporation owning business, commercial or industrial property in Glenview.”

Commission decisions are final and not subject to Board of Trustee approval.

The Commission:

- Approves the appearance of commercial buildings and landscaping (e.g., scale, color, parking lot screening).
- Approves the appearance of signage and lighting (e.g., sign color and size; where and how brightly any lights will shine.)
- Issues Certificates of Appropriateness, which commercial and industrial owners must have in order to make exterior changes to their structures.

Meetings

Commission meetings are generally held on the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month at 7 p.m. in the Village Hall Board Room, 1225 Waukegan Road.

Agendas are usually posted at the Village Hall on the day of each meeting; you can also visit www.glenview.il.us.

Meetings are sometimes canceled or re-scheduled. In addition, special meetings are sometimes scheduled to address key issues. To be sure, call the Community Development Department at (847) 904-4340 or check online at glenview.il.us.

Public Comment at meetings

Public comment is welcome on specific agenda items at each meeting. Simply fill out a speaker card when you enter the room and give it to the Commission secretary. The Chairman will call on you at the appropriate time during the meeting.

If you would like to address the Commission on a matter that is *not* on a particular agenda, make your request, in writing, to the Chairman no later than seven business days before the meeting (keep in mind your request may not be granted — call to check). Address your request to:
