Historic Preservation Commission

The Historic Preservation Commission is charged with **preserving the Village's historic buildings and areas by "landmarking" them**, which protects them from demolition and ensures that any alterations are sensitive to their historical character. It is a "recommending body;" final landmarking decisions are made by the Village Board of Trustees

The Commission is made up of members of the Glenview Appearance Commission.

Did you know:

- **Anyone can nominate a property for landmark status.** *Districts* must be nominated by their property owners and 51 percent of its property owners of record must agree.
- In either case, they **must meet at least one of nine criteria**, including whether or not the building or area has architectural significance or can be identified with someone who made a significant contribution to the community (call 847.904.4340 for a full list.)
- **Documentation is key.** Lincoln may have slept in the bedroom, but you'll need hard evidence to prove it.

Meetings

Commission meetings are held four times a year in the Village Hall Board Room, 2500 East Lake Avenue.

Agendas are posted at the Village Hall at least 48 hours before each meeting; you can also find meeting dates online at: www.glenview.il.us.

Meetings are sometimes canceled or re-scheduled. In addition, special meetings are sometimes scheduled to address key issues. To be sure, call the Village Community Development Department at 847.904.4340, go online to www.glenview.il.us or watch GVTV.

Public Comment at Meetings

Public comment is welcome on specific agenda items at each meeting. The Chairman will call on you at the appropriate time during the meeting.

If you would like to address the Commission on a matter that is *not* on a particular agenda, **make your request, in writing, to the Chairman no later than seven business days before the meeting** (keep in mind your request may not be granted — call to check). Address your request to:

*Because the Illinois Preservation Commission has given Glenview **Certified Local Government Status**, owners of landmarked buildings or in landmarked districts may be eligible for **certain grants and/or tax relief** available through the Illinois Historic Preservation Agency and the Cook County Assessor's Office to help offset maintenance costs.*
