### **VILLAGE SEEKS APPLICATIONS FOR TRUSTEE VACANCY**

**April 14, 2021** – The Village of Glenview is seeking candidates for the position of Trustee to fill a vacancy on the Village Board for a two-year term.

The vacancy will be created when current Village Trustee Mike Jenny is sworn in as Village President May 4. Jenny was elected at the April 6 Consolidated Election. As governed by the Illinois Municipal Code, municipal vacancies in Glenview are filled by the appointment of the Village President with the advice and consent of the Village Board.

To qualify as a candidate for the appointment, the applicant must meet the eligibility requirements of the Illinois Municipal Code for the position of Village Trustee, including being a registered voter in Glenview and a Glenview resident for at least one year.

Those interested are asked to submit a statement of interest and a resume. The submission should explain why the applicant should be considered and what knowledge and skills they would bring as a Village Trustee.

Trustees serve at-large, meaning they each represent the entire community, not a specific area. The Village Board of Trustees regularly meets the first and third Tuesdays of the month, and members also participate in budget meetings, strategic planning and other workshops or public hearings as necessary. As representatives of the community, Trustees also attend special events and other events of interest.
