1. Time and Place of Opening Bids. Sealed proposals for the construction of the **Harms Road Relief Sewers and Pumping Station and the Cunliff Park Pumping Station Project** for the Village of Glenview, Cook County, Illinois, will be received at the **Village of Glenview's Administrative Services Department, Office of the Purchasing Analyst, Glenview Village Hall, 1225 Waukegan Road, Glenview, IL 60025** until **2:00 P.M. local time, May 5th, 2014** and at that time will be publicly opened and the lump sum bid read aloud.

2. Description of Work. The proposed construction generally consists of the following:

A. Harms Road Relief Sewers and Pumping Station, generally including:

1. Wilmette Avenue Diversion Structure,
2. Glenview Road Diversion Structure,
3. Harms Road Junction Structure,
4. Harms Road 84-inch Relief Sewer,
5. Harms Road 54-inch Relief Sewer and 48-inch Force Main,
6. Harms Road Pumping Station and Generator Building,
7. Reconstruction and restoration of Harms Road and Glenview Road,

The project includes demolition of various residential structures; trenching, excavation and backfill; reinforced concrete; masonry, insulation and face brick; carpentry; preformed metal roofing; pipe and fittings; HVAC equipment; electrical equipment; manhole, catch basins, and inlets; storm sewer pipe; process instrumentation and controls; storm water pumping equipment; natural gas engine generator equipment; utility relocation; traffic control and protection; landscaping surface restoration; and all other miscellaneous items of work required for a complete and fully operational installation.

B. Cunliff Park Pumping Station, generally including the Pumping Station, Junction Chamber, and Generator Building

The project includes trenching, excavation and backfill; reinforced concrete; masonry, insulation and face brick; carpentry; roofing; pipe and fittings; HVAC equipment; electrical equipment; manholes, catch basins, and inlets; storm sewer; process instrumentation and controls; storm

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water pumping equipment; natural gas engine generator equipment; utility relocations, traffic control and protection; landscaping and surface restoration; and all other miscellaneous items of work required for a complete and fully operational installation, and other miscellaneous items of work.

All work under this contract shall comply with the Prevailing Wage Act of the State of Illinois, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 *et seq.* & the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act (30 ILCS 570/0.01 *et. seq.*). **Furthermore, this project is being funded in part by the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRGDC), and the Village of Glenview will award this contract using the MWRDGC's Purchasing Act, 70 ILCS 2605/11.1-11.24, the MWRDGC's Multi-Project Labor Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding, as well as the MWRDGC's Affirmative Action Requirements and Affirmative Action Ordinance as minimum requirements.**

The Village of Glenview is exempt from the Illinois State, Municipal and County Retail, Retailers Occupation Tax, Service Occupation Tax, Use Tax, and Service Use Tax as described in Illinois Compiled Statute Chapter 35. Bid prices shall not include the cost of such taxes.

All Bids must be accompanied by a Bidder's Bond, Certified or Bank Cashier's Check payable to the Village of Glenview for ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Bid as provided in the Bidder Instructions.

A pre-bid conference of all prospective Bidders and/or their representatives will be held at the **Glenview Police Department Community Room, 2500 E Lake Avenue, Glenview, Illinois 60026** on **April 17, 2014 at 10:00 AM**. Site tours of each project location will be conducted (transportation will not be provided). Bidders are encouraged to attend and participate in the conference.

Offers may not be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the bid opening date without the consent of the Village of Glenview.

Any Bid submitted unsealed, unsigned, fax transmissions or received subsequent to the aforementioned date and time, will be disqualified and returned to the bidder.

4. Rejection of Bids. The Village of Glenview Board of Trustees reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive technicalities. Unless the Bids are rejected for good cause, award of contract shall be made to the lowest responsible and responsive Bidder.
