

LEGAL NOTICE

Official notice is hereby given that separate sealed bids will be received in the Office of the Purchasing Analyst, Administrative Services Department, Glenview Village Hall, 1225 Waukegan Road, Glenview, IL 60025 until 2:00 p.m. local time on June 24, 2014, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud for the following:

Scope of work includes approximately 4,250 linear feet of six (6) inch and 3,000 feet of twelve (12) inch of cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) water main lining. The improvements will also include 600 linear feet of water main replacement of various pipe sizes; hydrant, valve, and water service replacements; sewer televising; pavement restoration; and parkway restoration.

There is a \$60.00 non-refundable charge for the bid documents. Checks, money orders, credit cards or cash made payable to the Village of Glenview are the accepted method of payment.

All bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond, Certified or Cashier's Check made payable to the Village of Glenview for not less than five percent (5%) of the bid amount. The successful bidder must furnish a satisfactory performance and payment bond in the full amount of the bid.

All work under this contract shall comply with the Prevailing Wage Act of the State of Illinois, 820 ILCS 130/1 *et seq.* & the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act (30 ILCS 570/).

Offers may not be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the bid date without the consent of the Board of Trustees.

Any Bid submitted unsealed, unsigned, fax transmissions or received subsequent to the aforementioned date and time, will be disqualified and returned to the bidder.

The Villages reserve the right to reject any and all bids or parts thereof, to waive any irregularities or informalities in bid procedures and to award the contract in a manner best serving the interest of the Village.
