- 2. Description of Work. The proposed construction generally consists of the following:
- A. <u>Harms Road Pumping Station, generally including, Pumping Station, and Generator Building</u>

The project includes demolition of various residential structures and trees on the property site; trenching, excavation and backfill; reinforced concrete; masonry, insulation and face brick; carpentry; preformed metal roofing; pipe and fittings; HVAC equipment; electrical equipment; manholes, catch basins and inlets; storm sewer piping; process instrumentation and controls; stormwater pumping equipment; natural gas engine generator equipment; traffic control and protection; landscaping surface restoration; and all other miscellaneous items of work required for a complete and fully operational installation.

B. <u>Cunliff Park Pumping Station, generally including the Pumping Station, Junction Chamber, and Generator Building</u>

The project includes trenching, excavation and backfill; reinforced concrete; masonry, insulation and face brick; carpentry; roofing; pipe and fittings; HVAC equipment; electrical equipment; manholes, catch basins and inlets; storm sewer; process instrumentation and controls; stormwater pumping equipment; natural gas engine generator equipment; utility relocations, traffic control and protection; landscaping and surface restoration; and all other miscellaneous items of work required for a complete and fully operational installation.

3. <u>Information for Bidders</u>. All pertinent documents may be **examined** on the internet at **www.bhfx.net**.

All work under this contract shall comply with the Prevailing Wage Act of the State of Illinois, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 *et seq.* & the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act (30 ILCS 570/0.01 *et seq.*). Bidders shall comply with the Village of Glenview MBE/WBE/SBE participation goals.

The Village of Glenview is exempt from the Illinois State, Municipal and County Retail, Retailers Occupation Tax, Service Occupation Tax, Use Tax, and Service Use Tax as described in Illinois Compiled Statute Chapter 35. Bid prices shall not include the cost of such taxes.

All Bids must be accompanied by a Bidder's Bond, Certified or Bank Cashier's Check payable to the Village of Glenview for ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Bid as provided in the Bidder Instructions.

There will be NO pre-bid conference. Bidders are encouraged to visit each project site and familiarize themselves with the existing project conditions.

Offers may not be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the bid opening date without the consent of the Village of Glenview.

Any Bid submitted unsealed, unsigned, fax transmissions or received subsequent to the aforementioned date and time, will be disqualified and returned to the bidder.

4. <u>Rejection of Bids</u>. The Village of Glenview Board of Trustees reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive technicalities. Unless the Bids are rejected for good cause, award of contract shall be made to the lowest responsible and responsive Bidder.
