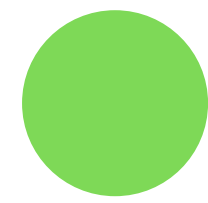


GLENVIEW BICYCLE & PEDESTRIAN PLAN

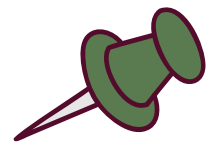


BIKEWAY TOOLKIT

The following bikeway typologies are examples of the proposed facility types that Glenview could potentially employ in the future as they grow its bicycle network. Of course, not all facility types are appropriate for every roadway. Instead, each has criteria that, when followed, provide the highest potential for safety and comfort for bicyclists.



PLACE YOUR THREE (3) GREEN DOTS ON THE FACILITIES YOU WOULD MOST WANT TO SEE IN GLENVIEW.



PLACE A GREEN PIN ON THE EXISTING CONDITIONS MAP WHERE YOU WOULD LIKE TO SEE NEW BIKEWAY FACILITIES AND WRITE THE FACILITY TYPE YOU WOULD PREFER.

SHARED LANES

Marked shared lanes or “sharrows” are pavement markings used to indicate a roadway that is suitable for bicycling that also is shared with automobiles. Marked shared lanes are intended for use on low stress roadways.

BUFFERED BIKE LANES

Buffered bike lanes are conventional bicycle lanes paired with a designated buffer space separating the bicycle lane from the adjacent motor vehicle travel lane and/or parking lane.

CYCLE TRACK

A cycle track is an exclusive bike facility that combines the user experience of a physically-separated path with the on-street infrastructure of a conventional bike lane. Cycle tracks may be one-way or two-way.

SHARED USE PATH

A shared use path provides a travel area separate from motorized traffic for bicyclists, pedestrians, skaters, wheelchair users, joggers, and other users. Shared use paths can provide a low-stress experience for a variety of users.

TWO-STAGE TURN BOX

A two-stage turn box provides bicyclists with the ability to complete a left turn in two stages rather than needing to move left into traffic to complete a left turn.

BIKE PARKING

Bicycle parking is an important part of a municipality's cycling infrastructure. The parking facility types can include bike racks, bike lockers, bike shelters, bike parking spots, and/or hanging bike racks.
