### PURPOSE AND ACTION REQUESTED:

Village staff requests Village Board consideration of a Resolution authorizing a bid award and approving a contract with DiMeo Brothers, Inc., ("DiMeo") of Elk Grove Village, Illinois for the Mary Kay Lane and Pebbleford Lane Improvement Project ("Project") in the amount of \$3,048,986.90 plus a \$48,000 contingency, for an amount not to exceed \$3,096,987.

#### PROPOSAL AND BACKGROUND:

The Village is committed to investing in the replacement and rehabilitation of aging surface and underground infrastructure. The proposed Project includes approximately 0.8 miles of improvements on Mary Kay Lane and Pebbleford Lane from Maple Leaf Drive to Greenwood Road (see Attachment 1 Project Location Map).

#### Scope of Work

The following major improvements are included in this contract:

- Water main improvements include the installation of approximately 3,900 feet of 8-inch and 12inch Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) water main and services on Mary Kay Lane and Pebbleford Lane.
- The proposed storm sewer improvements include installation of 1,600 feet of 12-inch to 24-inch storm sewer.
- The proposed sanitary sewer improvements consist of pipe and sanitary manhole repairs and replacement of sanitary services, if necessary.
- The proposed pavement improvements consist of trench patching over utility installations and resurfacing the entire road after underground utilities replacement/upgrades are complete.

Project Timeline:

- Bid notice published October 20, 2022
- Bid opening date November 3, 2022
- Bid award January 17, 2023
- Approximate preconstruction meeting February 27, 2023

- Approximate starting date of construction March 13, 2023
- Approximate completion of construction July 14, 2023

## **DISCUSSION AND REFERENCES:**

On November 3, 2022, six (6) bids from responsive and responsible contractors for the above referenced Project were submitted to the Village. The contractors and total bid amounts submitted were as follows:

DiMeo was the lowest responsive bidder with a bid price of \$3,048,986.90. DiMeo is prequalified by IDOT to complete the components of work included in this Project. DiMeo has previously worked in the Village of Glenview, and all their work has been satisfactory.

### BUDGET:

Funding was approved by the Village Board in conjunction with the FY2023 CIP budget. The requested contract approval is \$3,048,987 plus a \$48,000 contingency, for an amount not to exceed \$3,096,987, which is within the budgeted amount. The proposed improvements are to be funded by the Village as follows:
