- Meters must be picked up at the Public Service Center, 2498 East Lake Road. <u>Please call the Public Works</u>
  <u>Service Center at 847-657-3030</u>, before coming to pick up the meter between 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. at that location to
  <u>make sure that someone is available to assist you.</u> Sometimes the water department is in the field, in meetings or
  training and therefore, no one is available for assistance.
- Taps will only be done from Tuesday to Thursday. There will be no taps on Monday and Friday.
- Meters must be installed by the plumber prior to calling for a final inspection.
