**Glenview Incident Summary  
April 9, 2024**

**Incidents:**

**24-14328 Criminal Damage to Property**

On 04/02/2024 at 0839 hours, a resident of the 900 block of Lenox, reported they were notified by a neighbor that unknown offenders attempted to enter their vehicle parked on the driveway on 03/31/2024 at 0445 hours. The offenders did not make entry but damaged the front passenger side window.

**24-14380 Harassment by Electronic Communication**

On 04/02/2024 at 1559 hours, a resident of the 4100 block of Essex Court, reported receiving threatening messages from an ex-friend. The messages were implying physical harm. They were advised to cease communication.

**24-14430 Criminal Damage**

On 04/02/2024 at 2054 hours, an agent for property in the 2200 block of Sanders Road, reported two unknown offenders were seen on video entering the building at 1930 hours and they did not see them exit. Two exterior glass doors and four windows were damaged. Nobody was found in the building. Estimate damage is \$16,000.

On 04/04/2024 at 0841 hours, employees for a business in the 2300 block of Capital Drive, reported two unknown Hispanic male offenders entered the liquor section and one of the males placed four bottles of Jack Daniels into his jacket, then left the store without paying. The second male returned 20 minutes later and the manager told him the police were coming. The male ran to the parking lot. A third unknown male had been waiting outside the store. They were seen running through the parking lot and were not seen entering any vehicle. Estimated loss is \$87.96

The owner gave the male \$84.63 cash as change for the order. The male then left. A neighboring business advised them that the bill was possibly counterfeit and the same male was in their store, but did not complete a transaction. The male was seen entering a blue Ford Focus parked in the lot, occupied by 3 other people. The male offender is described as a male black, 18-19 yoa, 5'06"-5'07", 170-180 lbs, black dread locks, brown eyes, wearing a graffiti t-shirt and skinny jeans.

On 04/07/2024 at 0808 hours, Officers responded to 1333 Greenwood Road for a report of a small fire inside the dugout. They located a melted garbage can and wood benches that had been damaged. There were beer cans and dog feces in the garbage can that appeared to be the source of the fire. Glenview Fire Department personnel estimate the fire starting 2-4 hours prior to the call. On 04/07/2024 at 2008 hours, employees a business in the 2300 block of Capital Drive, reported three counterfeit \$100 bills were located while closing out the registers. The bills were each used at a different register, but they were unable to view their surveillance video for a time or to provide a description of the offender. Complaints will be signed.

The male stated he was from US Bank and asked them for their routing number from their check, which they provided. They then became suspicious and hung up the call. The homeowner called ATT, who reported an unknown person placed a block on the phone line and had calls forwarded to a different phone number. They do not believe there is any financial loss at this time and the phone line has been restored.

On 04/08/2024 at 0729 hours, employees for a business in the 3800 block of Willow Road, reported on 04/07/2024 at 1700 hours, an unknown male Black, mid 20's, with dreadlocks and silver teeth, with tattoos on both cheeks and both sides of his neck, purchased food and paid for the meal with a \$100. The male received approximately \$80 cash in change. Employees did not realize the \$100 was counterfeit until the male left the store. No complaints to be signed.
