# Bike Glenview kicks off for second year

April 28, 2014 – May is National Bike Month, and the kick off of the second year of Bike Glenview. This community-wide initiative and resource promotes biking as a healthy, cost-effective and low-polluting way to travel around our Village. The initiative is made possible through a cooperative effort of the Village of Glenview, Glenview Park District, Glenview Public Library, Glenview Natural Resources Commission and Glenview Chamber of Commerce.

There are some exciting new features this year:

- Ride a Bike—Win a Bike Anyone who rides their bike to Park Center, 2400 Chestnut Ave., any day during the month of May and brings their bike helmet inside receives a free bottle of water, small cup of coffee or bottle of Gatorade at Perk Center Café. They will also be entered into a drawing for a new bicycle. The free drink and entry will be provided each time; there's no limit for any individual bike rider. The winner will be announced after a random drawing in early June. Sponsored by George Garner Cyclery and Perk Center Café.
- **Five instructive videos** will be posted on our Bike Glenview website (bikeglenview.com). They'll provide tips on how to adjust a bike seat, maintenance essentials, an "ABC" precheck, properly fitting a bike helmet and tools at the bike repair station next to Little Bear Park in Gallery Park.

## Other Bike Glenview features:

Free bike route maps are available for residents all Glenview Park District facilities; Glenview
Village Hall, 1225 Waukegan Road; and the Glenview Public Library, 1930 Glenview Road. The

map shows existing bike routes and paths, sidewalks along major arterials that can be used by bicycles; "fun" routes through neighborhoods that link 20 Glenview hubs and attractioins in downtown Glenview, The Glen, Gallery Park, The Grove and more; and a tour of Glenview's most interesting and beautiful natural areas.

- The Bike Glenview website(bikeglenview.com) provides information on bike safety tips,a list of 2014 Bike Glenview events and access to our bike trail and green infrastructure tour maps.
- Bike map signs are posted at key locations on the bike routes in town to help traveling bikers.
